The Project Read® curriculum, is a complete research-based language arts program which includes instructional materials for phonics, reading comprehension, and writing. This time-tested curriculum was developed in 1973 by Dr. Mary Lee Enfield and Victoria Greene. The curriculum honors diverse learning profiles and provides lessons built on direct concept teaching, targeted multisensory strategies, and higher-level thinking skills.

### All workshops

### Four Workshops offered in 2020

**Framing Your Thoughts Sentence Structure Written Expression and Paragraph Writing (K-12)** teaches the fundamentals of sentence writing and paragraph construction. This curriculum uses unique graphic symbols to illustrate the sentence parts and their function. The instructional strategies blend creative freedom and accuracy with direct multisensory skill instruction.

**Report Form Process (3<sup>rd</sup> to Adult)** teaches students a systematic multisensory process for interacting, analyzing, systematizing, classifying and organizing informational text for higher-level thinking and test-taking strategies.

**Phonics** curriculum applies sound/symbol knowledge to spelling and reading comprehension using targeted multisensory activities and direct instruction.

**Linguistics (3<sup>rd</sup> to Adult)** is an accelerated phonics program tailored for grade 3 through adult learners. This multisensory curriculum builds upon prior knowledge through a sound/symbol organization chart that displays the 44 speech sounds and their alternative spellings.
